Application for using semen from sires that are not approved by Danish Warmblood and / or not on Danish Warmblood's official stallion list

In order to let the Dansk Varmblod mare owners use good foreign sporthorse stallions with the purpose to improve the mare owner's breedingstock, it has been decided that sires that are not approved by Dansk Varmblod or not on Dansk Varmblod's official stallion list, but approved by another of the by Dansk Varmblod approved sporthorse studbooks (please see 1.3 in "Rules for stallion grading in USA") can be used for breeding Dansk Varmblod offspring. Not all of them can be used, as such sires must correspond to the quality demands on the back side of this application form, if the offspring is to be registered with Dansk Varmblod, get marked with the crown and wave and this way to achieve the same possibilities as other foals bred within the frames of Dansk Varmblod. A prerequisite for applying is, however, that the mare is graded with Dansk Varmblod.

When the foal is registered with Dansk Varmblod in its year of birth, all applying rules herefore, set by the National Committee on Horses must be respected, i.e. DNA tests of foal, dam, and sire, if requested.

Latest date of applying is December 31st in the year of covering/insemination

Quality demands regarding the breeding value of the used sire:

Germany:

The stallion must be graded in one of the studbooks listed in 1.3 in "Rules for stallion grading in USA". If the stallion belongs to the so-called group of younger stallions (oldest offspring placed in competition max 6 years old) or group 1 (oldest offspring placed in competition 7-14 y.o.) the stallion must fulfill at least one of the following demands:

1. Passed station test in Leistungsklasse 1 (score of 120 or more or at least a score of 130 in either dressage or jumping)
2. Genetic evaluations among the best 10% of the breed in either dressage or jumping
3. Placings on international S-level

If the stallion belongs to group II (oldest offspring placed in competitions more than 15 y.o.), the stallion must fulfill either point 2 or 3. Furthermore, young stallions are approved, if they have passed a 30-day-test. The permission is valid in the year of passing the test and the year after, according to the rules of the respective studbook.

The Netherlands:

The stallion must be selected to the KWPN sporthorse studbook, and must have passed a station test. If genetic evaluations based on competition results in either dressage or jumping have been made for the stallion, these must be at least 126, thus corresponding to the best 10% of the breed.

France:

The stallion must belong to the best 10% in jumping, corresponding to a BSO genetic evaluation of at least 13.

Other countries:

The breeding value of the stallion must be at the same level as the above listed conditions.

NB!

It is the duty of the applying mare owner to find and enclose documentaion of the above results. Furthermore, it is on the owner's expence, if/when DNA or bloodtype control is required on either sire, mare, or foal.
